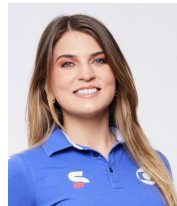

**11:20 | SILVER BULLETS FOR SPORT INTEGRITY: SIRVS & SIGA SOLUTIONS**

Integrity has become a go-to catchphrase in many realms, not least within sport. However, the definition of Integrity seems too often be both politically convenient and fluid – to say the least. For Integrity to be meaningful it must be implemented on a day-to-day basis, and evidence must be produced – proclamations and self-assessments are not enough. To help deliver the much-needed cultural change from rhetoric to reality SIGA is facilitating an independent solution: The SIGA Independent Rating and Verification System (SIRVS). The purpose of SIRVS is to assess and rate the sporting organisations' level of implementation of and compliance with the SIGA Universal Standards. Accountability and scrutiny are the keys to Integrity. In this panel you will hear the opinion of leading players on the importance of mechanisms such as SIRVS to guarantee that sport is governed and operated by the highest standards of integrity.

**14:00 | G20 & B20 – KEY PRIORITIES OF THE BRAZILIAN PRESIDENCY ON SPORT**

In 2024, Brazil will assume the G20 presidency, being responsible for organizing the next Summit of Heads of State and Government and holding high-level preparatory meetings with engagement groups, such as the B20. This will be a decisive moment for Brazil to take the lead on major discussions, including tackling corruption in different sectors. In sports, for example, it is urgent to attack the deep roots of institutional corruption, led by individuals and criminal organizations. This panel reveals what is being discussed in readiness for the G20 and B20 in Brazil and shows how sport can be included in the debate agenda, promoting consensus that could shape the future of the industry.

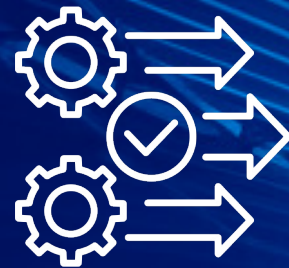
