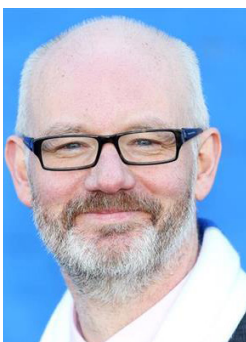

Mathieu Winand is a Professor of Sport Management and Head of Department of Management at LUNEX International University of Health, Exercise and Sports in Luxembourg. He is also the Programme Leader for the Master in Sport Management and Digitalisation.

Before joining LUNEX in 2017, he worked at the University of Stirling (UK) where he held the post of Programme Director for the MSc in Sport Management. Before moving to Stirling in 2012, Mathieu was Postdoctoral Researcher at KU Leuven (Belgium), and Research fellow at the Université catholique de Louvain (Belgium) where he obtained his Ph.D. in 2009 on key determinants leading to high performing sport organisations.

Mathieu's academic expertise are in governance, strategic management and innovation in sport. His research examines performance management and organisational innovativeness of sport organisations, with a particular focus on sport federations. He also has interests in anti-doping education and processes of digitalization.

Mathieu has published in numerous peer-reviewed international journals and has co-edited the first research handbook on sport governance in 2019. Mathieu is Past Chair of the Strategic Interest Group 'Managing Sport' at European Academy of Management (EURAM) and has contributed to the international research group on Sport Policy Factors Leading to International Sporting Success (SPLISS). Dr. Parent's research examines the governance, organization, and strategic management of sports events (e.g., Olympic Games, Pan American Games, and Youth Olympic Games) and national sport systems. She has worked for the 2001 Games of la Francophonie and for the 2010 Olympic Winter Games. She is currently the president of SportCopywriters, a copywriting and consulting firm. Dr. Parent co-authored Managing Major Sports Events: Theory and Practice (2nd edition with Aurélie Ruetsch, Routledge, 2021), and co-edited The SAGE Handbook of Sport Management (with Russell Hoye, SAGE, 2017) and The Routledge Handbook of Sports Event Management (with Jean-Loup Chappelet, Routledge, 2015)."

Dr. Christos Anagnostopoulos is the Founder and Director of the UNESCO Chair on Governance and Social Responsibility in Sport (a Chair under a joint-leadership status between Hamad Bin Khalifa University in Qatar (HBKU) and UCLan Cyprus). He is an Assistant Professor in Sport Management at the College of Science and Engineering, where he teaches the MSc in Sport and Entertainment Management, a joint program with the University of South Carolina (USA).

He is an editorial board member in nine international scientific journals related to sport management, the co-editor (together with Prof. Winand) of the first Research Handbook on Sport Governance (2019, Edward Elgar), and the co-author (together with Dr. Papadimitriou, Dr. Byers, and Dr. Botwina) of the Sport Governance Insights book (2022, Routledge).

Since 2017, he has secured more than three million euros from leading and/or participating in seven European research projects dealing with sport governance and/or social responsibility in sport. In 2018, he was commissioned by the highest authority of sport in the Republic of Cyprus to write the first-ever Code of Good Governance for the national sport federations, while in 2021, he was appointed as the sole consultant for the development of a multi-criteria evaluation scheme that assesses the performance of the national sport federations.

He currently serves as an elected member at the executive board of the World Association for Sport Management.
