From October to December, i.e. the period covered by this Newsletter, we accelerated our mission to raise global awareness on Sport Integrity, welcomed new allies, and ventured into fresh, strategic 'markets'. SIGA's collective progress reaffirmed our core belief: only by uniting those committed to governing Sport under the highest integrity standards can we truly enact meaningful reform.

A key highlight of this period was the celebration of our annual world leading [Sport Integrity Week](#) (SIW). The 2024 edition was hosted from multiple venues across the globe, including Argentina, Brazil, the United States, Portugal, Sweden, Turkey, the United Kingdom, Ghana, Nigeria, and Saudi Arabia. Bringing together over 100 speakers and countless organizations, the event expanded SIGA's international footprint and sparked new partnerships and collaborations with Sports Summit, Cityscape Global, and Panathlon International, alongside deepening relationships with clubs, such as our Member São Paulo FC and CF Os Belenenses, among many other multi-industry stakeholders.



In this way, our critical mass is expanding, our capacities are increasing, and our appetite for reform grows ever stronger. These synergies have already led to tangible, impactful outcomes, notably the "[Manifesto for Sustainable Sport](#)" developed by the SIGA LATIN AMERICA Permanent Committee on Environment, Sustainability and Social Responsibility, paving the way for new Universal Standards in this crucial area of activity. SIGA's use of Sport as a catalyst to unite like-minded individuals and organisations for collective action was, once again, front-and-centre with another edition of the [Football Integrity Match](#) - partnering with São Paulo FC - and a special charity match in Curitiba, Brazil, in collaboration with Complexo Pelé Pequeno Príncipe. The [match](#), featured Brazilian and Barcelona legends, headlined by Romário, and showcased SIGA's crucial role as the events' Integrity Partner.

We continued championing reform by welcoming [new SIGA Champions](#) from the world of football: legends Sol Campbell, Gilberto Silva, and Nicola Innocentin joined the group of now 24 elite athletes/coaches - and strengthening our base with the expansion of our [membership when welcoming IFA 7 into the fold](#).

Our year culminated with the Anti-Corruption Week, during which we articulated our position and perspectives broadly, including through the publication of leading [op-eds](#) across multiple languages, calling upon the sports community to unite against corruption. In line with this message, we facilitated global stakeholders to join our campaign and sign the [New York Declaration on Financial Integrity and Transparency in Sport](#). Fittingly, we also announced the [SIGA FITS FORUM Lisbon 2025, on 27 January 2025](#) - a thought-leadership event poised to galvanize the brightest minds in Sport Integrity and deliver tangible action, whilst kick starting the year with a bang.

Our growth mindset was palpable in the closing months of 2024, and our trajectory of expansion and delivery is now in full motion as we look forward to what 2025 will bring. For everyone who believes the moment to embrace integrity-driven reform in Sport is now, the opportunity to make a difference is now. Join us, work with us and make 2025 a year to remember.

Thank you for shouldering with us on this journey. Together, we will continue shaping a future where Sport is governed, played, and cherished under the highest standards of integrity.

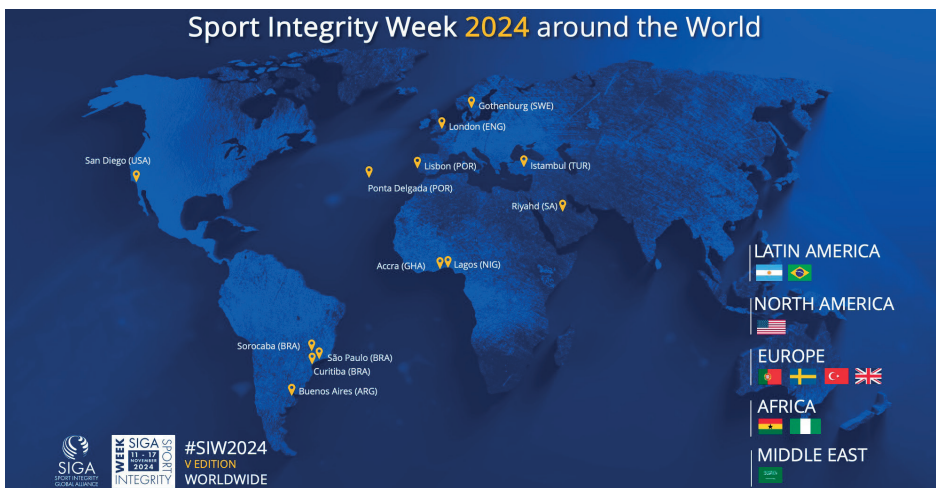
Sport Integrity Week 2024 Drives Worldwide Action

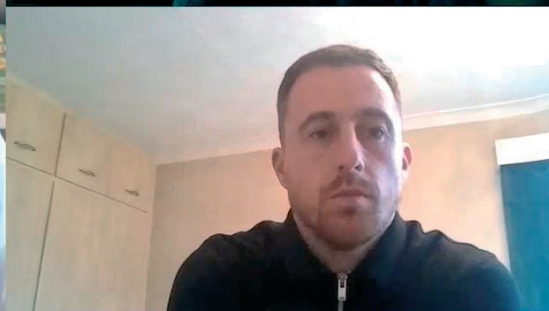

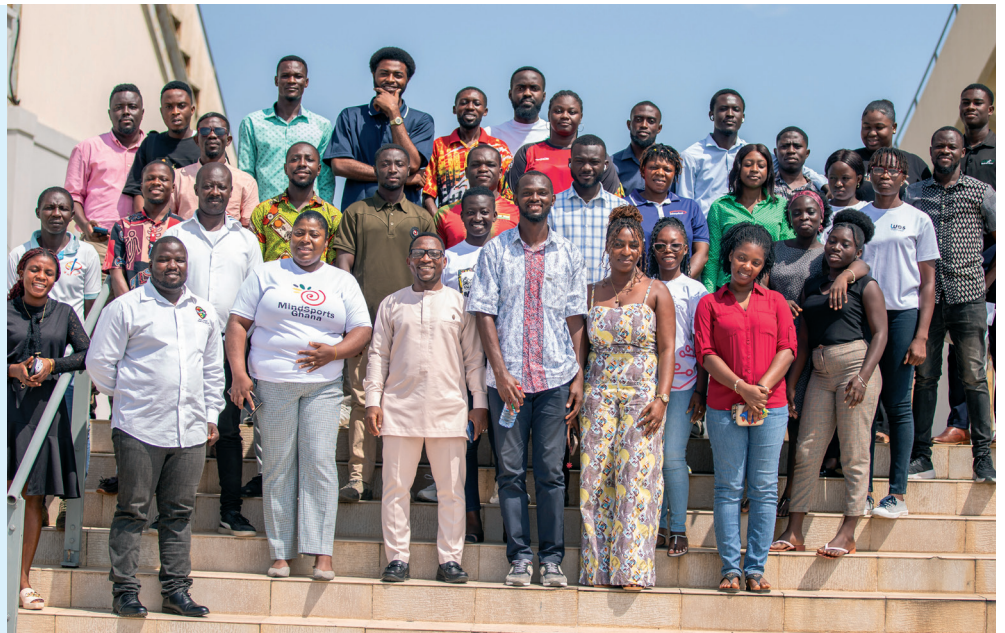

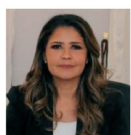

SIGA and Ministry of Finance Forge Cooperation for Sports Betting Integrity in Brazil

SIGA and SIGA LATIN AMERICA signed a significant Technical Cooperation Agreement with the Brazilian Ministry of Finance, represented by the Department of Prizes and Betting. This agreement, further solidifying SIGA's commitment to advancing Sports Integrity in Brazil, will enable the exchange of information, the monitoring of sports betting systems, and the identification of suspicious activities, including irregular betting patterns that may suggest attempts to compromise the integrity of sporting events and participants in Brazil.

Key objectives of the TCA include the sharing of information, ex-



pertise, and best practices between the parties while respecting legal confidentiality; training and capacity building through regular meetings, conferences, workshops, and other initiatives to increase awareness of sports integrity issues; the promotion of SIGA's Universal Standards on Sport Integrity, emphasizing Good

Governance, Financial Integrity, and Sports Betting Integrity; and cooperation with sports organizations, public authorities, betting operators, academia, and other relevant sectors.

SIGA Latin America has released a groundbreaking Manifesto for Sustainable Sport, unveiled during Sport Integrity Week 2024, calling on the Global Sports Community to champion environmental stewardship, sustainability, and social responsibility. Marking the start of SIGA's fifth pillar of Universal Standards on Sport Integrity, this initiative complements the ex-

isting standards on Good Governance in Sport, Financial Integrity, Sports Betting Integrity, and Youth Development & Protection. Through SIGA's Independent Rating and Verification System (SIRVS), the Manifesto will guide the implementation of robust practices that drive transparency and accountability across the Sport Industry.

Reinforcing the unique regional focus of SIGA Latin America while remaining aligned with SIGA's global

vision, the Manifesto commits to preserving biodiversity, tackling climate change, and promoting responsible operations. Its objectives include fostering sustainability literacy, organizing forums and academic projects, and establishing a wide network of public and private partners, culminating in the pledge to contribute to COP30 in Belém, Brazil (2025).

SIGA, Cristina Gonçalves, and APCL Join Efforts to Promote Inclusive and Sustainable Sport

A SIGA delegation led by Emanuel Macedo de Medeiros, Global CEO, and Nuno Perestrelo, Senior Director of Communication, Media & Thought Leadership Events, joined SIGA Champion Cristina Gonçalves at the Lisbon Association on Cerebral Palsy (APCL) for a hands-on Boccia training session. This visit exemplified SIGA's commitment to fostering inclusion in Sport, as the group learned about the challenges faced by para athletes and witnessed the determination that earned Gonçalves two Paralympic gold medals (Athens 2004 and Paris 2024), among other accolades. During discussions with APCL's

leadership, including General Director Anabela Fialho, participants addressed the need for resources, societal support, and strategies to remove barriers for athletes with disabilities. The visit concluded with an exchange of gifts: APCL presented a Boccia-themed artwork to SIGA's Global CEO, while SIGA gifted personalized jerseys to both APCL and Cristina Gonçalves, underlining the organization's dedication to building a global Sport culture rooted in inclusion and integrity.

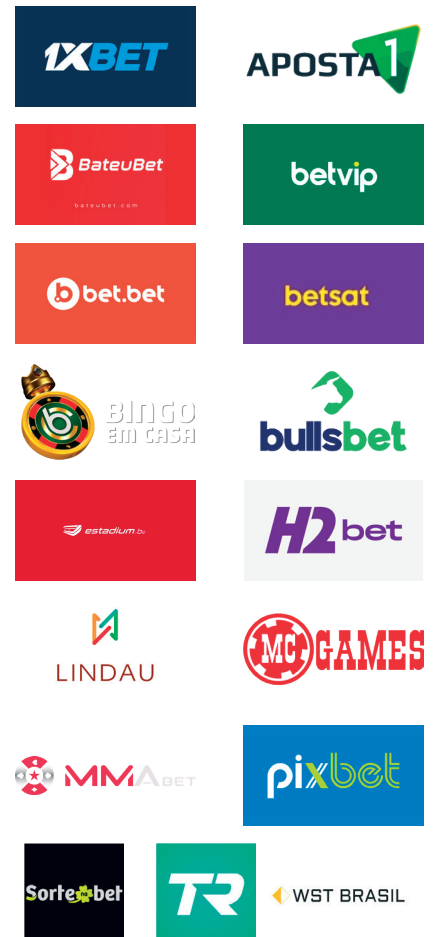
